Intervention (I) – What is the action (intervention, treatment) we are considering taking? Comparison (C) – To what other action (intervention, treatment) are we comparing the considered action? Outcome (O) – What do we anticipate as an outcome? 	P -Population I -Intervention C -Comparison O -Outcome	What are effective ways to deal with bullying in the workplace? •P - nurses •I - cognitive based rehearsal •C - no strategy? other strategies? •O - ? unknown
